Alumni Artwork on Display

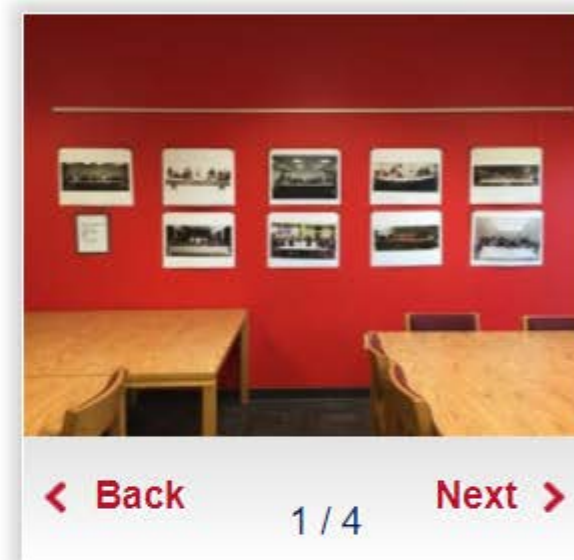
